HISTORY ABOUT ROGER D. COLBERT AND THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



Roger D. Colbert was born August 23, 1948 in Sparta, Illinois and passed away on March 15, 2003. Roger – nicknamed “Bubba” – was a true husband, father, grandfather and friend. He believed in getting involved and helping others. Roger joined the Millstadt Jaycees in April 1975. He served as State Director and two terms as Local President. After his second term in 1982, he served the Illinois Jaycees as District Director and Region Director of the Mississippi Valley Region. In 1988, Roger served as Area Vice President of the Illinois Jaycees followed by the appointed position of On-To Chairman of the Illinois Jaycee delegation to the Louisville National Convention.

Roger received JCI Senatorship #38086 in May 1985. He immediately became active in the Illinois JCI Senate. He served two terms as Mississippi Valley Region Director followed by one term each as Administrative Vice President, Management Vice President, Assistant to the President, State President and Chairman of the Board. Roger also served as Senate On-To Chairman for the Greensboro, SC National Convention in 1992 and the Dayton, Ohio National Convention in 2001. As a member of the Illinois Senate, he served on the Life Account Committee including one year as Chairman. Roger was appointed as the Ambassador to Canada for four years by the US JCI Senate. During this time, Roger also served as a member and advisor on the Illinois Jaycee Charitable Foundation Board of Directors.

Roger worked at General Motors for 35 years as a spot welder and team leader. He was a U.S. Navy veteran and belonged to VFW Post 502 in Millstadt where he served as Commander. Roger’s loves were the Jaycees, golf and NASCAR. He often traveled to races to cheer his favorite driver – Rusty Wallace.

Upon Roger’s untimely death, his family named the Illinois Jaycee Charitable Foundation as one of his memorial recipients. As the result of a \$1,400 donation made in Roger’s name, the Foundation decided to honor Roger with a scholarship named on his behalf. Therefore, the Roger D. Colbert Memorial Scholarship Award was established beginning in 2004. Originally, two graduating seniors from Illinois were to receive a \$500 scholarship to the education institution of their choice during their first year of college.

In order to maintain financial support for the scholarship fund, the Illinois Jaycee Charitable Foundation established the annual Roger D. Colbert Memorial Golf Tournament, commonly called the “Bubba Bash”, to be held on the last Saturday of June at Roger’s golf course in Millstadt where he played and worked as a course marshal. This golf outing is the sole means of providing funds for all future scholarships. There are several ways in which local Jaycee chapters, region organizations, JCI Senate organizations, local businesses or individuals can contribute to the success of this worthwhile event. Naturally, participation in the golf tournament is one but the main source of revenue is through hole sponsorships and individual donations. Any donation of \$50 will qualify the donor as a hole sponsor. All donations are made through the Foundation which is credited towards qualifying the donor as a Contributing Member of the Illinois Jaycee Charitable Foundation.
