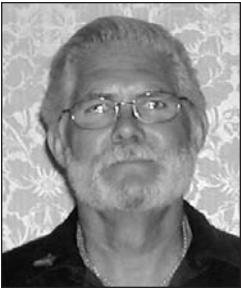

## RECENT APPROVED BY-LAW & POLICY CHANGES

The By-Law and Policy Review Committee has published the latest changes to the Illinois JCI Senate By-Laws and Policies that were approved at the January 2011 Business Meeting. As we began a new administration, it is felt that a reminder of these changes should be published so that all members are familiar with these changes in the future. These changes effect the latest publication located in the Illinois JCI Senate Directory. A complete updated version of the by-laws and policies is being added to the Illinois Senate website for easy referral by the membership.

### By-Laws

#### Article IV – Elections

- change the use of the term Nominating Committee to Election Committee throughout the Article.
- Section 1 – add to read: Members of the Election Committee shall be past presidents of the organization. The President will appoint the chairman of the Election Committee
- Section 8 – add to read: Shall an office be unopposed, voting may be by voice acclamation.

#### Article VII – Meetings

- Section 1 – change to read: The organization will conduct five (5) regular meetings during each administrative fiscal year. The Summer business meetings will be held each July at the Annual Picnic. The Fall, Winter and Spring business meetings will be held the same weekend and location that the Illinois Jaycees hold their similar General Assembly meetings. The Summer business meeting held at the end of each fiscal year should consist of appropriate final reports, end of year business, and the President’s annual report and final comments. Notice of these meetings will be mailed to each member, at their last known address, in the issue of *The Forum*, prior to each meeting.

#### Article IX – Committees

- add Section 6 – A separate checking account may be established for special projects upon approval of the Board of Directors. A committee treasurer can manage such account under the supervision of the Illinois Senate Treasurer. A copy of all monthly statements of each such account shall be sent to the Illinois Senate Treasurer.

#### Article XIV – Amendments

- Section 2 – change the term Revision Committee to Bylaw Review Committee

#### Article XV – Policy

- Section 2 – change the term Revision Committee to Bylaw Review Committee

### Policy

#### Policy 5 – TOYP

- paragraph D – change to read: The Illinois JCI Senate shall maintain a separate checking account for the TOYP program. At the close of each year’s TOYP program, an amount up to \$5,000 should remain in the account as a TOYP Reserve Fund. Any additional monies remaining in the account should be transferred to the General Fund prior to the end of the fiscal year the TOYP program was held. With approval through a majority vote of the membership at any regular membership meeting, part or all of the TOYP Reserve Fund may be transferred to the General Fund.

#### Policy 6 – Hospitality Room

- paragraph A – change to read: A hospitality room will be open and available for JCI Senators and their non-Senator spouse/significant other at the Fall Meeting, Winter Meeting and Spring Meeting from Friday evening to Sunday noon. Children and grandchildren under the age of 18 and those of special needs can be guests of the Senator in the hospitality room provided they are accompanied by the Senator, their non-Senator spouse/significant other or another specific responsible qualified adult. Under no circumstances will they be allowed to consume alcoholic beverages.

- paragraph C – change to read: Any member of the Illinois JCI Senate and their non-Senator spouse/significant other are eligible to participate in the activities of the hospitality room during the hours of operation at a cost of \$10 per person for the weekend or \$5 per person for Friday evening through Saturday breakfast or \$5 per person for Saturday breakfast through Sunday noon, provided they are in compliance with paragraph E of this Policy. Qualified children and grandchildren, age 6 and older, will be charged a \$5 fee for the weekend. Hospitality room participants must display a ribbon signifying participation authorization.
- paragraph F – change to read: A Hospitality Chairman shall be appointed by the President. The Hospitality Chairman will be responsible for coordinating and supervising the activities of the hospitality room, including assigning regions responsible for food preparation at each meeting, verification of eligible participants, collection of money and distribution of ribbons. The Hospitality Chairman may appoint additional committee members to assist. All additional committee members are subject to approval by the President.
- paragraph H – add to read: A Senator or their non-Senator spouse/significant other can earn a free hospitality pass for each time they qualify during an administrative year. These free passes can be used by the Senator or their spouse/significant other but are not transferable to any other person nor can they be used in any other administrative year. The free passes can only be used at the Fall, Winter or Spring Meetings.

**Policy 10 – Finance Committee**

- paragraph B – change second sentence to read: The Treasurer of the Finance Committee shall not be the Treasurer of the Illinois JCI Senate.
